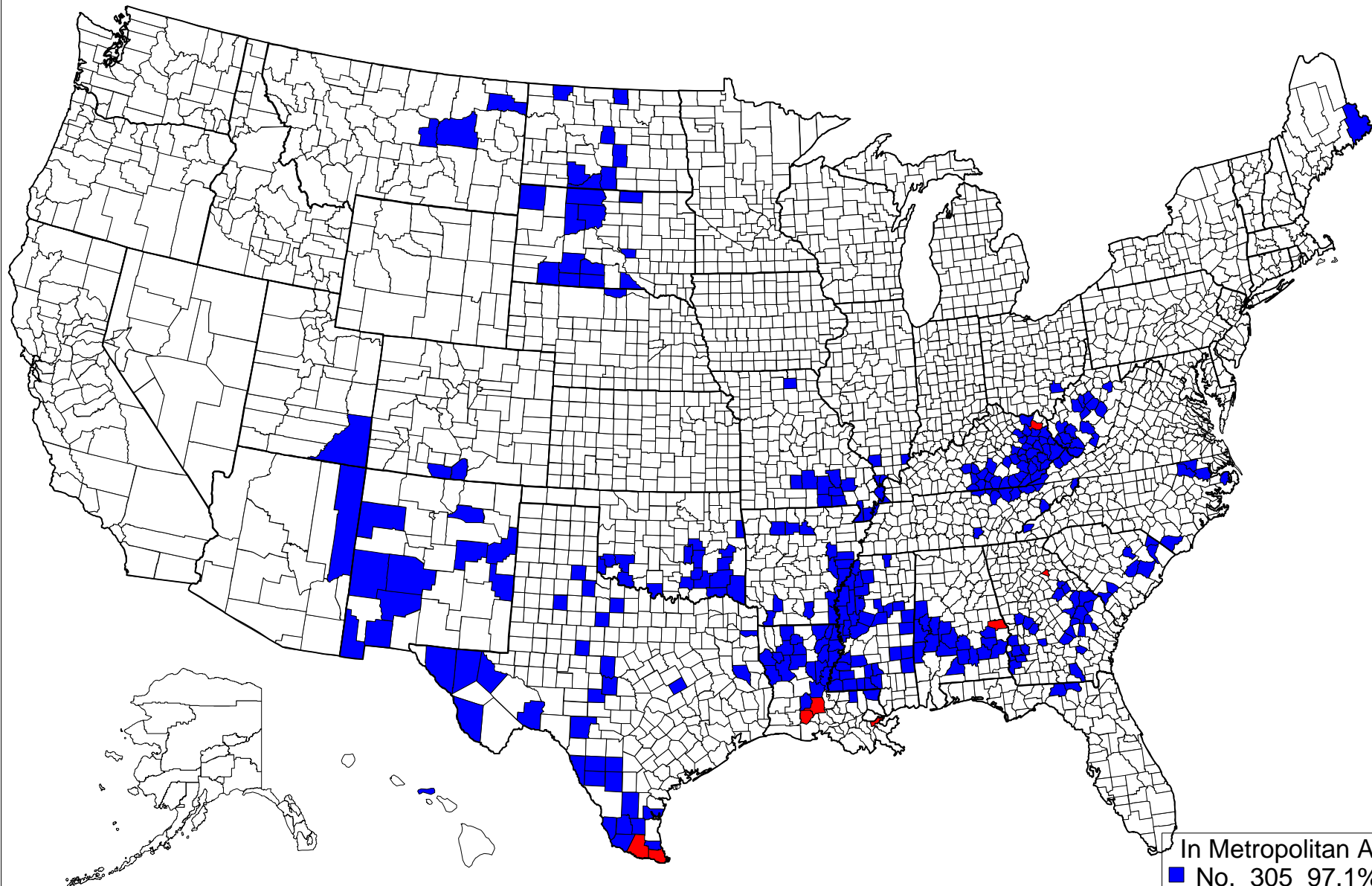
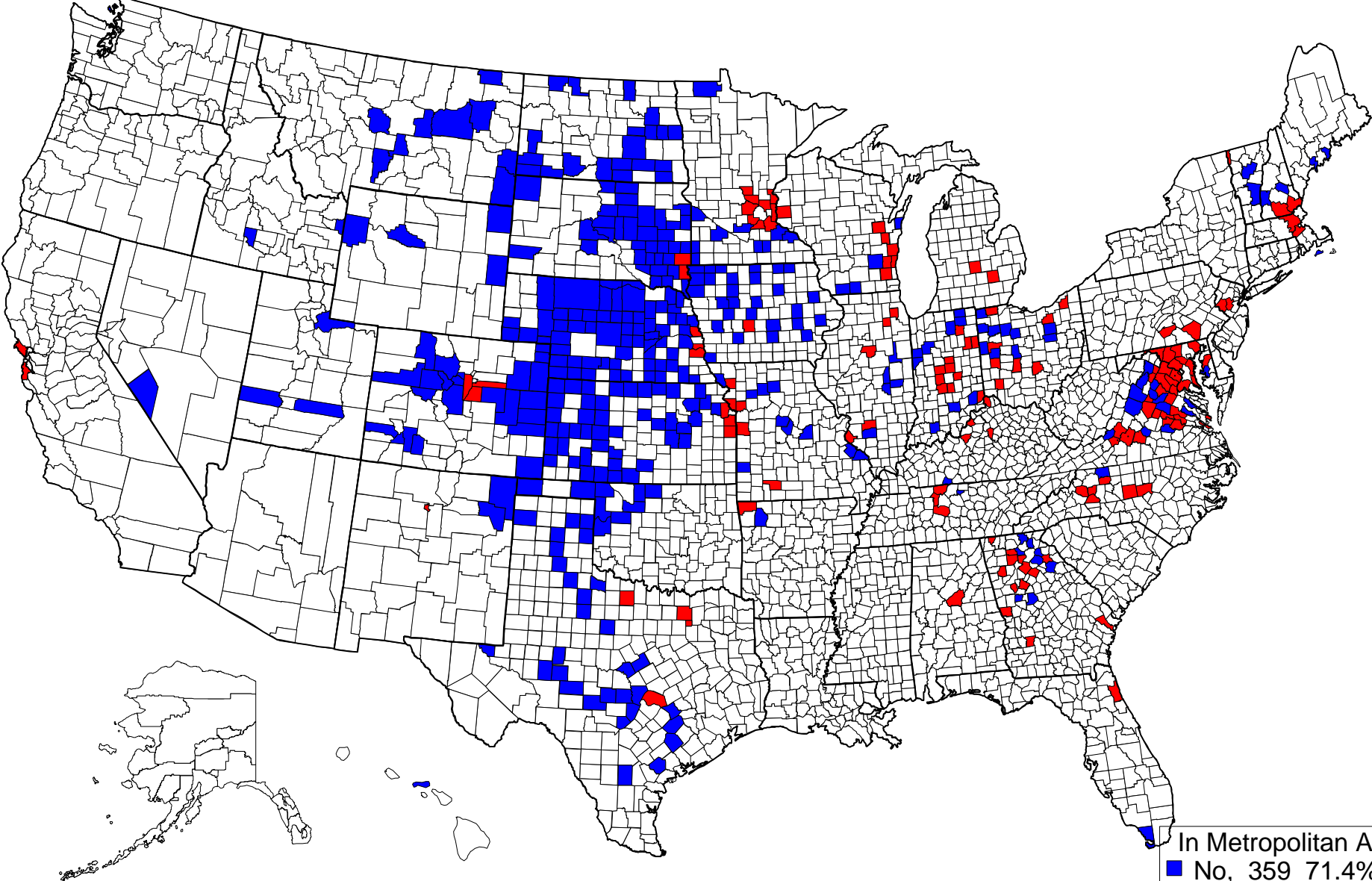


US Counties with % of Households with Income <\$15,000 in 90th Percentile ($\geq 29.56\%$) in 1999



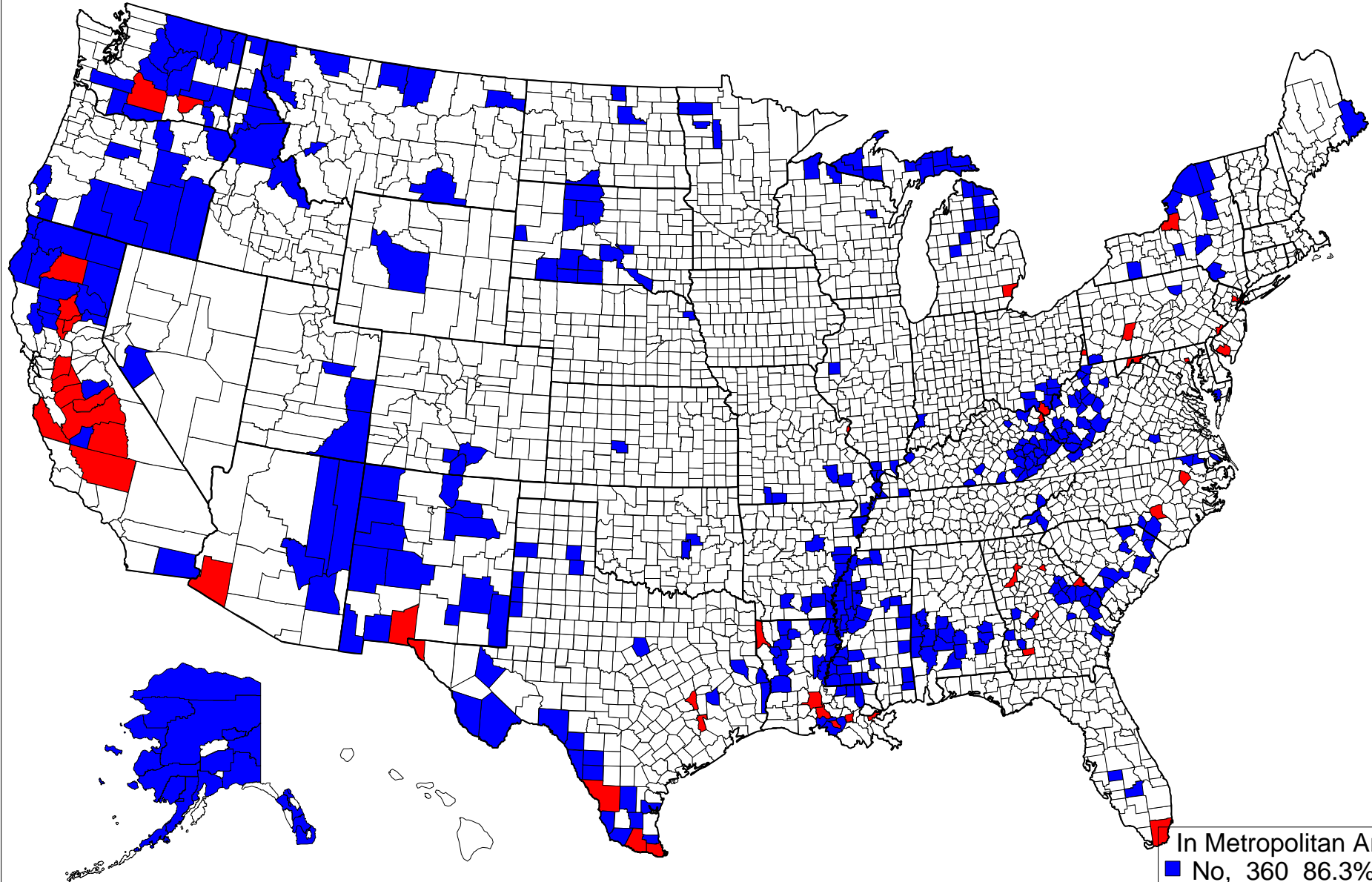

US Counties with Unemployment Rates in 10th Percentile ($\leq 3\%$) in 2000



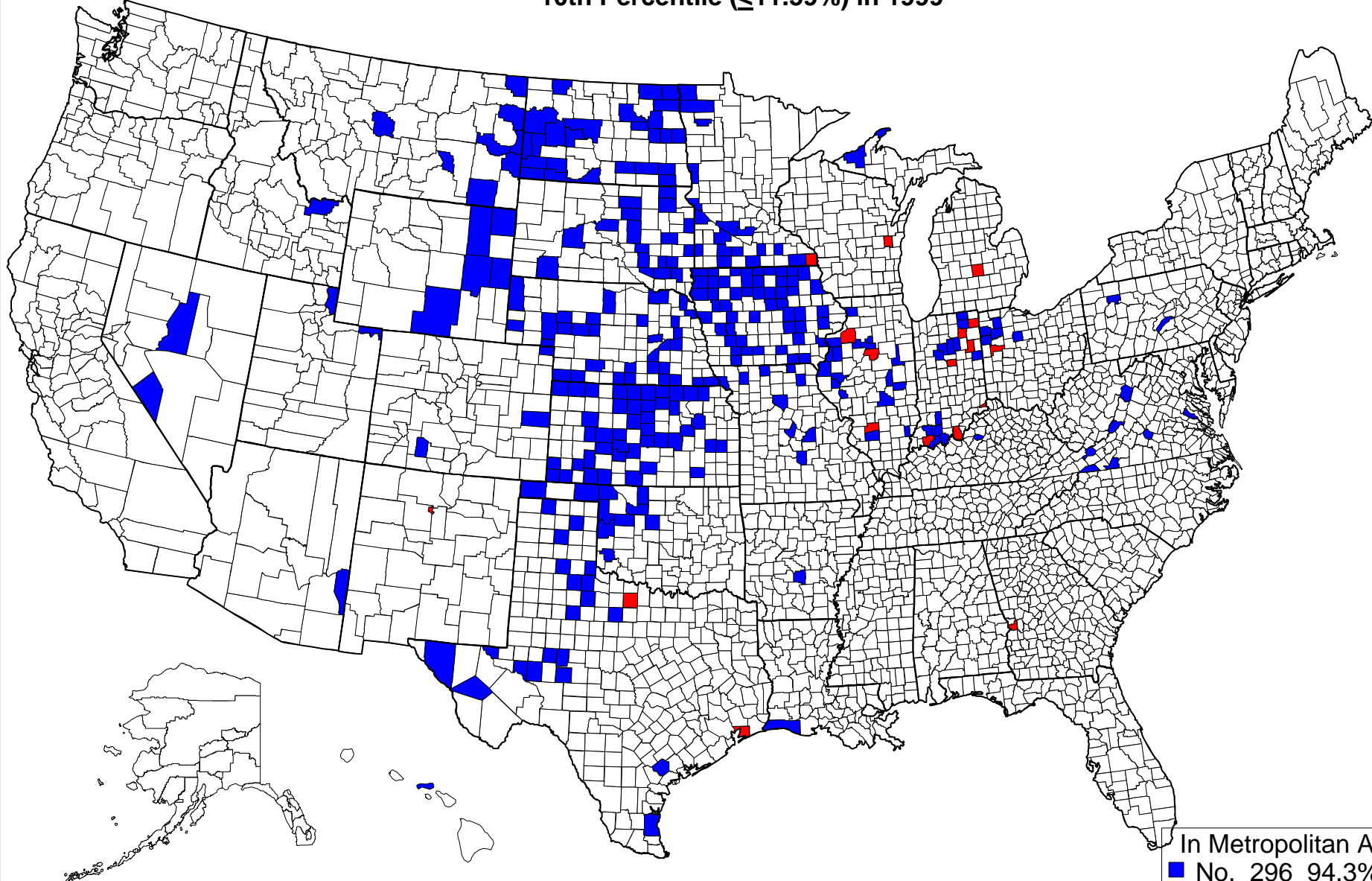
